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# **THE BUSIA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2022**

**An Act of the County Assembly of Busia to provide for measures to impose various taxes, levy fees and charges in respect of services rendered by the County Government; amend or vary various revenue raising laws and for other related matters incidental thereto.**

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of the Busia, as follows; -
