BUSIA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2022

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THE BUSIA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2022

An Act of the County Assembly of Busia to provide for measures to impose various taxes, levy fees and charges in respect of services rendered by the County Government; amend or vary various revenue raising laws and for other related matters incidental thereto.

ENACTED by the County Assembly of the Busia, as follows; -

PART I – PRELIMINARY

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Busia County Finance Act, 2021, and shall, subject to section 25 of the County Governments Act and subsection (2), commence and come into operation upon publication.

Short title and Commencement

(2) The Executive Committee Member may bring into operation different sections and /or Schedules or parts thereof at different times.

Interpretation

- 2. In this Act, unless the context requires a different interpretation—
 "agricultural services" include crop farming, horticulture, floriculture, livestock farming, veterinary services, fishing and fisheries, aquaculture and shall also include training services offered at the Busia Agricultural Training Centre and other training centres in the County:
 - "County" means Busia County established under Article 6
 - (1) of the Constitution;
 - "Constitution" means the Constitution of Kenya 2010;
 - "County Assembly" means the County Assembly of Busia established in accordance with the Constitution;
 - "The County Government" means the county government for the County;
 - "The County Executive Committee" means the County Executive Committee of the County;
 - "The Executive Committee Member" means the Member of the County Executive Committee responsible for matters relating to finance.
 - "The County Receiver of Revenue" means the public officer in the County Treasury appointed in accordance with Public Finance Management Act and the County Revenue Administration and Management Act of the County.
 - "Cess" means the fee charged under and as defined in the County Cess Act;
 - "Rateable Property" has the meaning given to it in the Rating Act of the County;

PART II —TAXES, RATES, FEES, CHARGES AND OTHER RECEIPTS PAYABLE AND APPLICABLE

3. (1) The County Government shall have power to impose taxes, fees and charges on businesses, activities and services offered by County Government as provided in the Schedules herein.

Power to impose tax and levy fees

(2) Subject to the provisions of this Act, any laws, regulations, guidelines, directions, restrictions, orders or authorizations on or relating to financial management, including collection and administration of taxes, fees or charges, given or issued, enacted and or subsisting or valid in the County immediately before the repeal of the Local Governments Act (Cap. 265) shall be deemed to have been enacted, made, given or issued by the County Government until the expiry, amendment or repeal of such laws, regulations, guidelines, directions, restrictions, orders and authorizations.

Taxes and fees to be charged

4. The taxes, fees and charges set out in the charges column of the Schedules hereto—shall apply at the rates indicated for the respective services, items or activities listed in the items description column of the relevant Schedule.

Validity of fees and charges before Act

5. The taxes, fees and charges applicable and payable to the County Government at or immediately before the commencement of this Act, but which are not included in the Schedules to this Act, shall continue to apply under the specific and or general descriptions and legislation enacted by the County Assembly or Parliament as the case may be.

Fees in Agricultural and related services

6. The County Government shall levy and charge the fees prescribed in the First Schedule in respect of various agricultural services that it shall deliver in the County.

Fees on Impounded and attached property

- 7. The fees and charges prescribed in the Second Schedule, shall be imposed and charged by the County Government in respect of:
 - a) Impounded or attached items, goods or any other property; or,
 - b) Items, goods or other property stored or kept in a County yard or yards, store or stores after such impoundment or attachment.

8. The fees and charges prescribed in the Third Schedule shall be payable in respect of industrial attachment and training under this section.

Charged in respect of attachment and training

9. (1) The fees and or charges prescribed and set out in the Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Eighth, Tenth and Eleventh Schedules shall be fees imposed and levied or charged by the County Government as Single Business Permit in respect of licenses issued to businesses, trades and professions undertaken and or carried on in the County as indicated in the Item columns of the Schedules.

Fees for Single Businesses and trades

- (2) For avoidance of doubt, and aware of the National legislation governing and regulating standards on measurements and weights in Kenya, the charges and fees charged under the Weights and Measures Act are hereby adopted and incorporated in Part I of Schedule 6 to this Act.
- Whenever it shall consider it convenient and in the interest of the County, the County Government may lease or hire out to and for the use of any person its construction machines, plants and equipment and levy and impose in respect thereof the fees and charges prescribed in Part 2 of the Fifth Schedule.

Licenses in transport and roads sector

11. (1) In accordance with the provisions of the County Cess Act 2017 and the Trade Act and the Regulations made there-under, the County shall impose and charge in respect of the services given and delivered the cess and market and other fees and charges prescribed in the Sixth Schedule.

Payable cess and market fees

12. To ensure the preservation and protection of the water and natural resources of, and the environment of in the County, the County Government shall impose the fees and charges prescribed in the

Seventh Schedule to ensure effective and efficient delivery of the

(2) For purposes of this section and the Schedule, a market place includes

Water and natural resources

For the purpose of ensuring that the County Government provides effective, efficient and quality health services in the County, the fees and charges prescribed in the Eighth Schedule shall be paid in respect of the services delivered and the commodities and consumables used.

Applicable Fees for health services

The fees, charges and rates prescribed and as indicated in the Items column of the Ninth Schedule shall constitute the rates, fees, charges and rent payable in respect of the various activities relating to property in the County and for various services under Sections 15 and 16.

Rates payable under Valuation Roll, advertisements and building plans 15. (1) In accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of the Rating Act, the taxes and levies set out in the Busia County Valuation Roll approved by the Busia County Assembly, shall be the rates payable in respect of the land and property as published in the Valuation Roll.

Application of Rating Act No. 3 of 2017

(2) In accordance with section of the 22 Rating Act, the Executive Committee Member may prescribe interest to be charged on any rates or any part thereof that may remain unpaid after the day on which the rates became payable.

16. The County Government shall take measures to regulate and control outdoor advertisements and signage in the County, the County Government hereby imposes charges or fees as set out in the Ninth Schedule.

Outdoor advertisement

17. Every person who wishes to carry on or carries on business of an education or training institution in the County shall pay in respect thereof the fees and charges prescribed in the Tenth Schedule

Fees for establishment and operation of educational institutions

18. The County Government shall impose The taxes, levies and or fees prescribed in the Eleventh Schedule shall be paid in respect of the services and activities stated in the Items column of the Schedule undertaken or carried out in the County.

Promotion of Tourism and social cultural integration and regulation of certain activities

PART III—MISCELLENEOUS PROVISIONS

19. (1) All payments under this Act shall be made to the County Receiver of Revenue in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act and the Busia County Revenue Administration and Management Act.

Compliance with Public Finance Management Act and County Revenue Administration and Management Act

- (2) An official receipt shall be issued for every payment made to the County Receiver of Revenue.
- (3) Unless specifically authorized by law, a person shall not receive or collect money on behalf of the County Receiver of Revenue.
- 20. (1) Any person liable to pay or property subject to a tax, fees, levy or other charge who fails to make payment thereof within ninety (90) days from the date due shall pay a penalty of three (3) per centum compounded monthly of the amount payable during which the amount shall remain due and unpaid

Consequence of failure to pay tax or fees due

- (2) Before renewal of a license or a permit in respect of a service or business, the applicant for such a license or permit shall first pay all or any outstanding fees or charges in respect of the business or service.
- **21.** The Executive Committee Member may, with the approval of the County Executive Committee impose a penalty in respect of the arrears or part of the arrears outstanding and in default

Imposition of Penalty by Executive Member

22. The Executive Committee Member may, with the approval of the County Executive Committee exempt, waive, or vary, fees or charges payable under this Act as an incentive or relief.
